CRYSTAL RIDGE GOLF CLUB IS “BUSINESS AS USUAL” FOR GUESTS WITH PROOF OF COVID-19 IMMUNIZATION.

EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 15TH WE ARE IMPLEMENTING THE RESTRICTIONS EXEMPTION PROGRAM.

As of November 15, the Alberta government will begin limiting the types of proof of vaccination that will be accepted by businesses.

With the new restrictions for proof of vaccination in place, these will be our new valid types of proof of vaccination:

1. Alberta vaccine record with a QR code (printed or digital)
2. First Nations immunization record
3. Canadian Armed Forces vaccine record
4. Vaccine records issued by other provinces and territories
5. Valid proof of medical exemption
6. Negative privately-paid COVID-19 test from within the previous 72 hours
7. ArriveCAN app for international travellers and valid international travel identity document

Masks will continue to be mandatory at Crystal Ridge Golf Club and can only be removed while seated, eating, or drinking.

You may be required to lower your mask briefly upon entering for identification.

Food and beverage service will resume with the last call for alcohol at 10 PM and one hour for consumption. There will be no service after 11 PM.

Please be advised there are no exceptions to any of these requirements at any time.
